## ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS

When a name, logo or mascot is to be chosen by a school, the school will:

1. Form a representative committee to identify a potential name or names for approval by the principal. Composition of the committee will include:

- Students
- Parents
- Teachers
- Administrative officers
- Community members when appropriate

2. Expectations:
A. Names, logos and mascots must be considerate of gender and cultural sensitivities. If a name, logo or mascot is representative of a specific cultural group, that group must be consulted. Nevertheless, a chosen name, logo or mascot must be acceptable to the broader community as well.
B. Names, logos and mascots must not conflict with the goals and culture of the school.
C. Corporate names, logos and mascots must be avoided.
D. Schools must respect other schools' names, logos and mascots when choosing their own.
E. Copyrights must be respected.
3. New names, logos and mascots must be reported to the Board.
