SCHOOL SITE ACQUISITION

ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS

- 1. The Board will identify the need for a school site in a general area through its Capital Plan.
- 2. The Board will issue a request of interest from potential agents before selecting an agent to aid the Board in purchasing the school site. Acceptable agents must have the following knowledge and skills:
 - a. Demonstrated ability to work confidentially with public bodies and others.
 - b. Demonstrated ability to work with property owners to accumulate land for large projects.
 - c. Signed statement confirming no financial interest in properties under consideration or obligations or relationships with owners or developers.
- 3. The Secretary-Treasurer will prepare a shortlist of applicants for the Board.
- 4. The Board will convene an in camera meeting to hear presentations from shortlisted applicants and to make a final decision regarding the successful candidate.
- 5. Upon receiving Ministry of Education permission to proceed with the acquisition of a new school site, the Board will instruct the Secretary-Treasurer to engage the agent to acquire the necessary land without identifying the School Board as the interested buyer. The Secretary-Treasurer will work with the Ministry of Education in identifying the appropriate site size to guide the agent.
- 6. Once the agent has identified land available for purchase by the Board, he or she will present the options at an in camera meeting for the Board's approval.
- 7. Only after the purchase is complete will the Board make its decision public.

Definition:

An *agent* will be an individual or company with the requisite knowledge and skills to enable the effective completion of a site acquisition for the Board. The agent must have no personal or corporate interest in the land considered for purchase.
