# City of Colwood Transportation Master Plan

- Adopted in 2015
- Multi-modal plan
- Encourages mode shift away from cars to walking, cycling and transit

# Travel Modes

- Walking
- Bicycle Lanes
  - Ideally designed for 8yrs to 80yrs
- Transit
  - School Busses and BC Transit
- Driving
  - Drivers and passenger rides

# Parent / Student Survey

- Royal Bay Secondary (others to follow)
- Conducted Nov/Dec 2015 – 233 Responses
- |           | To School | From School |
|-----------|-----------|-------------|
| • Walk    | 22%       | 27.5%       |
| • Bicycle | 2%        | 2%          |
| • Bus     | 36.5%     | 37.5%       |
| • Car     | 36.5%     | 31%         |
| • Other   | 3%        | 2%          |

# Parent / Student Survey (cont'd)

- 67.5% of current Car and Bus passengers / drivers would walk if safer sidewalks and trails were available
- 61% think new trails would make the walk / cycle trip quicker
- Proposed projects from Transportation Plan
- Also asked for Student Suggestions

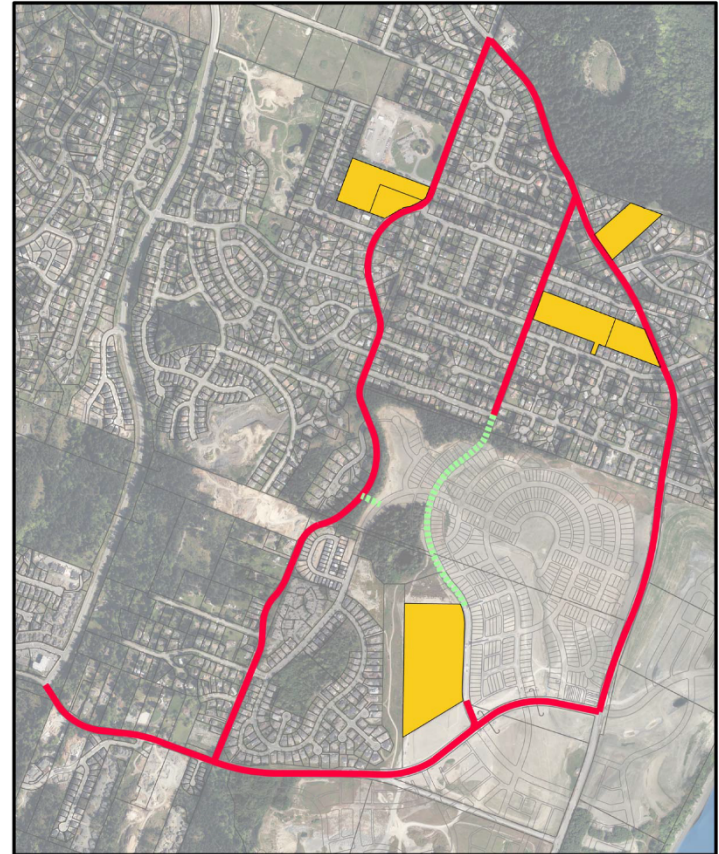
# Projects

  - Design underway – Trail & Road Sections in 2016
- Latoria Road
  - Safety @VMP in 2016 – Developer Driven Sidewalks
- Metchosin Road
  - Beginning in 2016 - in sections
  - Benhomer to Lagoon, incl Pedestrian Crossing
- Wishart Road
  - Beginning in 2017 – in sections

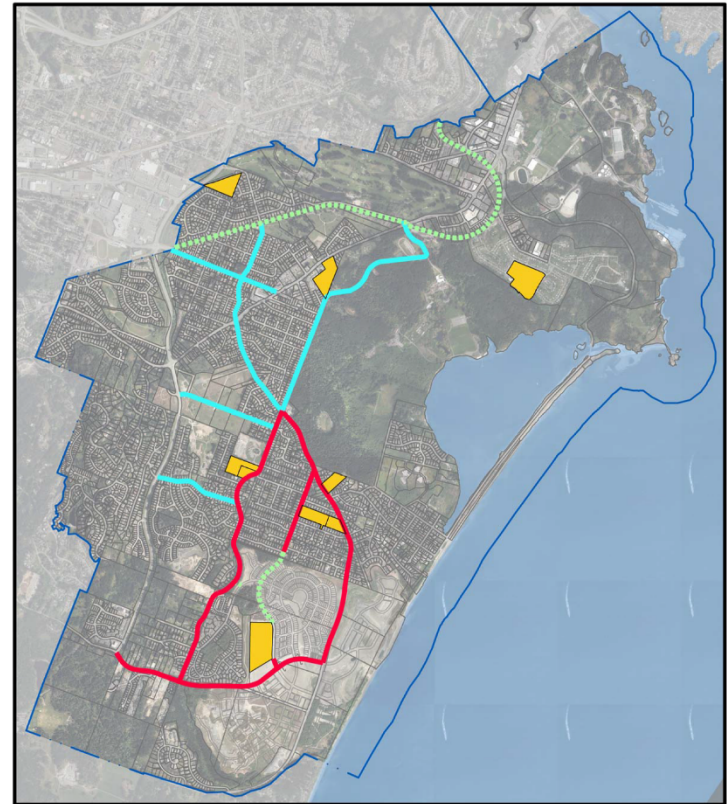
