

Port Renfrew 2025-26 School Plan

School Context: Port Renfrew Elementary is in the rural community of Port Renfrew on the traditional territory of the Pacheedaht Nation. It is situated on the beautiful inlet of Port San Juan surrounded by beaches, forest, and wildlife. Port Renfrew is 70km from the closest town. Our school has 2 classes with students in Kindergarten to Grade 5.

Goal #1: Increase student numeracy proficiency.

Actions/Strategies:

- Use a data driven approach to develop a numeracy plan for the school year.
- Invite the curriculum team to enhance numeracy practice.
- Explore and integrate manipulatives and hands-on resources available to develop students' conceptual understanding of numbers.
- Familiarize ourselves with the K-4 Mathematics Foundational Learning Progressions.
- Provide targeted small-group support based on formative assessment data. (Use combined class time to increase learning assistance time for students.)

Data/Evidence of Impact:

- Report card data; student proficiency levels generated from classroom formative assessment.
- Numeracy assessments used in coordination with the curriculum department in October and May.
- Anecdotal reflection on behaviour as numeracy proficiency increases.

Goal #2: Increase student literacy proficiency.

Actions/Strategies:

- Increase use of explicit and systematic teaching of reading and writing across all grades.
- Invite the curriculum team to visit to enhance our literacy practice.
- Familiarize ourselves with the K-4 Language Arts Foundational Learning Progressions.
- Provide targeted small-group support based on formative assessment data. (Use combined class time to increase learning assistance time for students.)

Data/Evidence of Impact:

- Report card data; student proficiency levels generated from classroom formative assessment.
- Literacy assessments used in coordination with the curriculum department in October and May.

- Anecdotal reflection on behaviour as literacy proficiency increases.
