Royal Bay has a solid foundation in the arts, sports and trades education. Our music department is well known in the province and our Theatre Department (Black Wing Theatre Company) is an important part of our local community. RBSS has three wellequipped shops designed to give students a professional trades experience, and a dual credit carpentry program.
